



Sometimes we do drills.

We do drills at home and at school. One of the drills we do at home or at school is an earthquake drill. In this way, we learn to stay safe!




When an earthquake happens, it is necessary to go somewhere safe at home or at school.





When a real earthquake occurs, the ground may move or buildings may sway.




During a real earthquake, the fire alarm does not usually sound. But, if there is also a fire on the earthquake site, alarm may sound.




During the earthquake drill, we can practice what to do and where to go and how to get in the line. A teacher or an adult can help us sit and wait in the classroom or at home.




