





WATCHING FIREWORKS




In the summer, many people

A lot of cities have firework shows on the 4th of July!




Many people love watching fireworks!




But, fireworks are loud.

my ears or wear headphones.




The fireworks are usually at night. It will be dark outside and the fireworks will make bright lights in the sky.




We might sit on a blanket or sit in lawn chairs to watch the fireworks.
