






When I'm at school I usually greet my friends and teachers.

But, there is a virus going around the world right now. It is called Coronavirus.




Coronavirus can make people get sick.




In school, we will not touch each other during greetings.

We can give air hugs.




We can wink at each other.


We can greet with spirit fingers.

We can also curtsy.



If we are wearing hats, we can tip our hats at each other.








We can also do an elbow bump!


