do on the plane to keep busy.



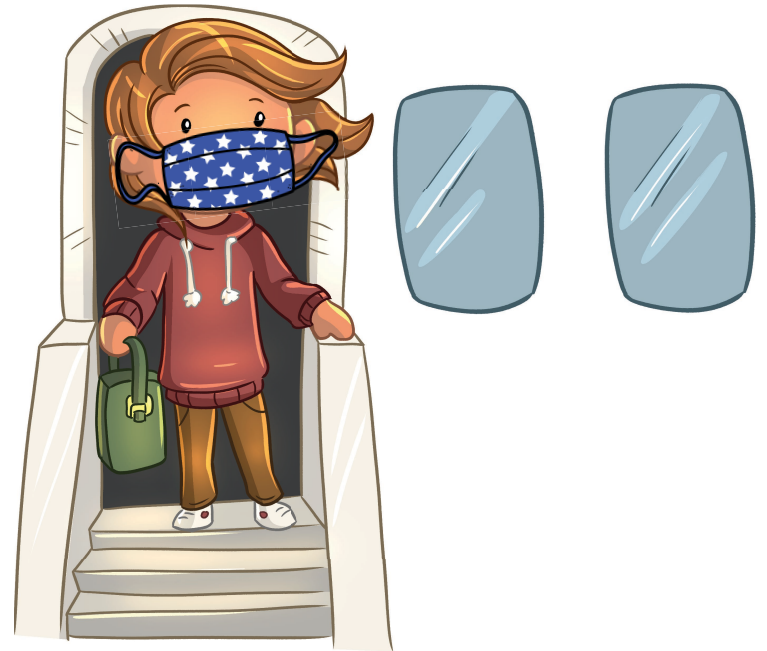
I can play on my tablet, listen

I can look out the window.



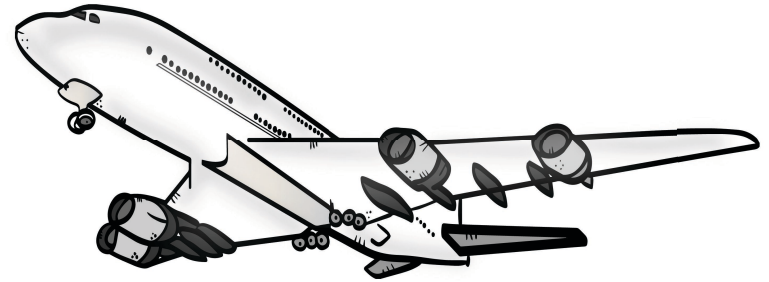
I can also sleep.
