

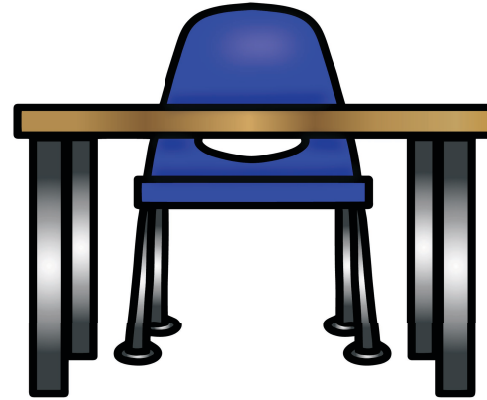
GOING BACK TO SCHOOL WITH ONLINE LEARNING



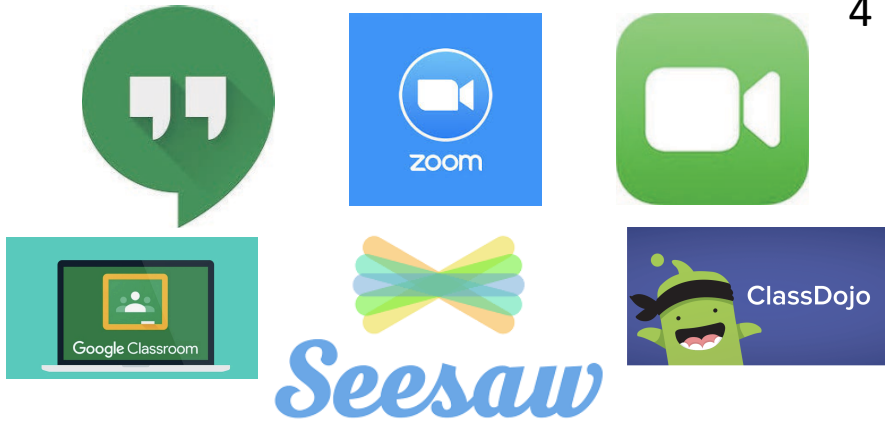
Going back to school looks different for me this year. I will not be going back to my school building.



Instead, I will be doing online learning. This means I will be at home during the school day.



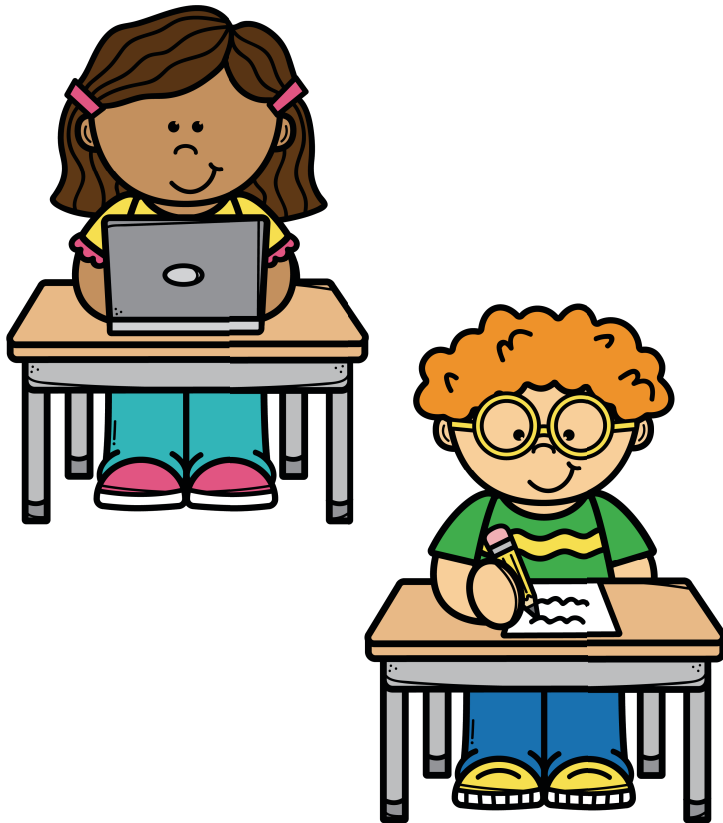
When I do online learning, it is important to find a desk or table in a quiet area to log into my device.



If I need help logging in, I should ask my parents or other adult.



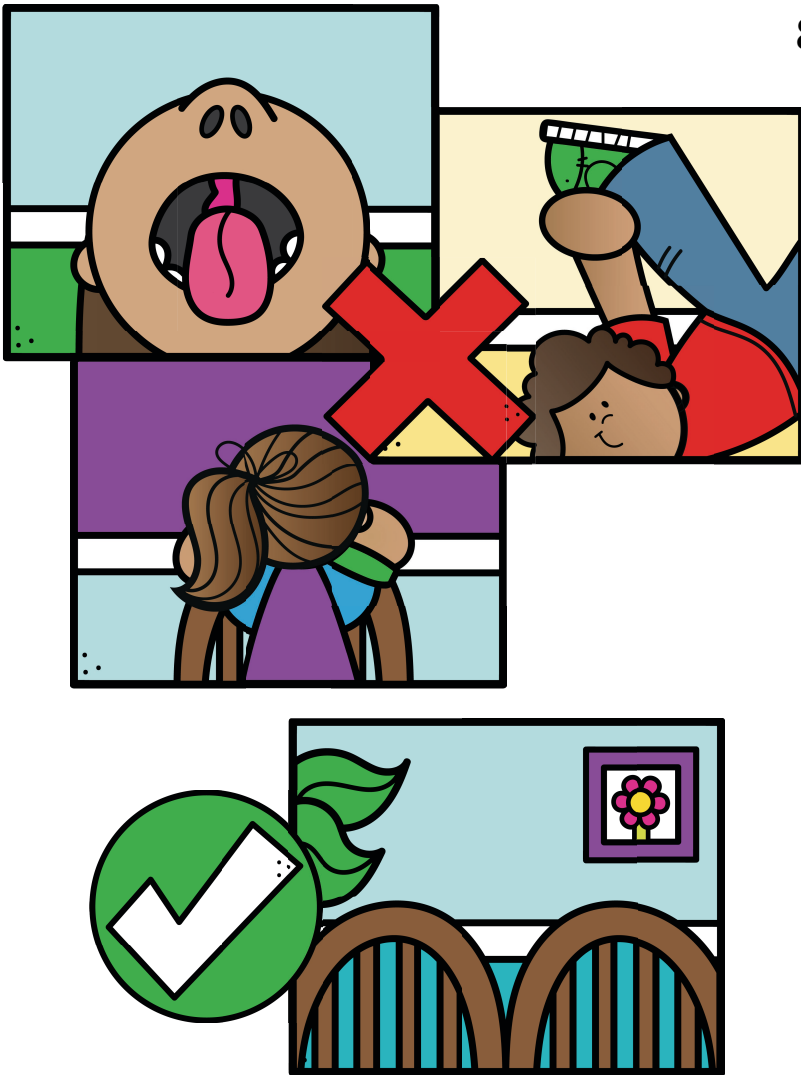
Once I am logged in there are two different types of learning. One is called synchronous. This means I am learning live with the teacher and other students.



The other type is asynchronous. This is when I am doing work or watching lessons, but my teacher is not live and I'm not interacting with my classmates.



During synchronous learning, it is important to follow my teachers directions. My teacher might say to turn my mic off or on.



It is best to face the screen, stay in my seat and follow the same rules that I would in the classroom.



I should wait until my teacher tells me the meeting is done before I leave the meeting.



If I need help with my schoolwork,
I can ask an adult at home or
message my teacher.

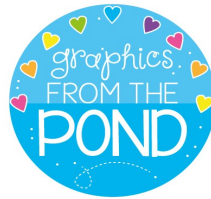
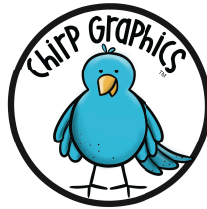
